I studied at St. Louis School from Form 1 to Form 6, graduating in Form 5 (HKCEE) in 1984 and completing Form 6 before entering The Chinese University of Hong Kong. I later obtained a PhD in Physics and have since devoted my career to education at CUHK. I am currently a Principal Lecturer in the Department of Physics. Over the years, in addition to teaching, I have been involved in programme management, curriculum development, and quality assurance reviews. My educational work has been recognized by many teaching awards at CUHK, including the Vice-Chancellor's Exemplary Teaching Award in 2024.

I believe education should broaden students' horizons, help them see the different paths open to them in life and career, and encourage them to grow into adaptable, thoughtful, and resilient people. Every student has his own talents, and with proper encouragement and guidance, each can strive to do his best. This belief has led me to take part not only in formal education but also in popular science education, through school talks, public events, and social media, in the hope of reaching more young people.

My commitment to education is deeply connected to my years at St. Louis School. It was here that I was given freedom, encouragement, and support to develop my interests and pursue my aspirations. The Fathers and teachers cared for us with patience and trust. They accepted our shortcomings, guided us with understanding, and encouraged us to keep improving. My classmates were bright, diligent, and self-motivated, and the school environment shaped my values and my growth in many important ways. I was baptized by Fr.
